Shelton #7760 and I am a peace officer of the City of Dallas, Dallas County, Texas. I, the affiant, have good reason and do believe that on or about the 1st day of, July 2016, one Martin Armijo Jr. [REDACTED], did then and there in the City of Dallas, Dallas County, Texas commit the offense of Murder, a violation of Section 19.02 of the Texas Penal Code, a FIRST DEGREE FELONY.

Affidavit's belief is based upon the following facts and information which Affiant received from:

Affiant's personal investigation of this alleged offense.

\_\_\_\_\_, a fellow peace officer of the City of Dallas, Dallas County, Texas, who personally participated in the investigation of this alleged offense, providing this information to Affiant, and whose information Affiant believes to be credible.

On July 1, 2016 at about 8:10 P.M., suspect Martin Armijo Jr. committed the offense of Murder, a violation of the Texas Penal Code (PC 19.02) F/1, against the complainant [REDACTED] at 755 Elwayne Avenue, Dallas, Dallas County, Texas.

The facts of the case are as follows:

On July 1, 2016, Dallas Police Officers responded to a 911 call at 755 Elwayne Avenue. The Officers were met by witness [REDACTED], who reported that the complainant had been murdered by suspect Martin Armijo inside the rear detached residence located at 755 Elwayne Avenue. The Officers approached the residence and observed individuals moving inside through the window. As the Officers approached, the suspect, later identified as Martin Armijo, exited the only door of the residence and fled on foot. Officers chased the suspect and captured him a short distance away. Other Officers entered the residence and found the complainant deceased on the floor and witness [REDACTED] crying for help. Witness [REDACTED] reported that the suspect had just killed the complainant and had tried to kill her. Witness [REDACTED] was transported to [REDACTED] Hospital and treated for her injuries. The suspect was transported to [REDACTED] Hospital and treated for [REDACTED] and later taken to the Dallas Police Homicide Unit. Witness [REDACTED] was transported to the Dallas Police Department Homicide Unit and interviewed.

Detectives C. Shelton, #7760 and P. Trujillano, #8874 responded to the offense location and investigated. The complainant had injuries consistent with blunt force injuries to the head and stab wounds to the arms and abdomen. A search of the residence revealed two semi-automatic pistols and one semi-automatic rifle.

Witness [REDACTED] was interviewed by Detective Trujillano. During the interview, witness [REDACTED] stated that while he was inside the residence with the complainant and the suspect, the suspect became angry and began striking the complainant on the head with a semi-automatic pistol. Witness [REDACTED] stated that he then fled the location and returned later. When witness [REDACTED] returned he observed that the complainant was unresponsive on the floor. Witness [REDACTED] then fled the location and called 911. During the interview, witness [REDACTED] viewed a six photo lineup containing suspect Armijo. Witness [REDACTED] positively identified suspect Armijo as the suspect that struck the complainant on the head with a pistol.

Detective Shelton interviewed witness [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] Hospital. Witness [REDACTED] stated that she came to the offense location and entered the residence. When she entered the residence, she observed the complainant lying on the floor and suspect Armijo standing inside. Witness [REDACTED] then observed the suspect strike the complainant on the head and body with a pistol and a bat. Witness [REDACTED] then observed the suspect cut the complainant several times with a knife and then pour bleach over his face. Witness [REDACTED] then observed the complainant become unresponsive. Witness [REDACTED] stated that at that time the suspect began striking her on the head and body with the pistol and bat. Witness [REDACTED] knows the suspect by name and date of birth and [REDACTED].
